The Swinomish Utility Authority (SUA) has a temporary part-time opening for a Utility Operator in training. This is a potential career path for interested, qualified and motivated individuals. The Operator in training will work side-by-side with current utility field staff performing routine and non-routine duties in maintaining and repairing the Tribe's extensive water and sewer systems.

Interested candidates must be at least 18 years of age, have a valid Washington State Driver's license, pass a pre-employment background and drug test and have average to above average reading comprehension and math abilities. Candidates must also be physically fit, able to work long hours outdoors, be able to lift 75 pounds, climb ladders, work in confined spaces and be proficient in the use of small hand tools.

Professional training opportunities in water and wastewater operations are also available.
