JOB DESCRIPTION

Graphic Designer

The Community Environmental Health Program at the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community is seeking proposals from graphic designers who specialize in development of graphics, including digital animation, for use online.

Position Duties:

- 80% Create/ design/ edit electronic materials—such as illustrations and graphics-- for a series of online teaching modules about Indigenous health (2-3 modules, approx. 10min in length each)
 - Conceptualize and execute designs
 - Prepare high-level illustrations and graphics
- 20% Consult with project team from Swinomish and Oregon State University regarding achieving project objectives and deliverables as well as design revisions for the project

Minimum Qualifications:

- 4+ years of graphic design experience OR Associate's Degree and 3 years of graphic design experience OR Bachelor's Degree and 2 years of graphic design experience. Degree may be in graphic design, graphic art, fine art or closely related field

Additional Required Qualifications:

- Skilled and/ or trained in illustration and computer aided drawing.
- Experience with Photoshop, Illustrator or other equivalent graphics programs.
- Excellent written and oral communication skills.
- Excellent computer skills which augment and support the efforts and duties of the position.
- Skills in various graphics software.
- Works collaboratively in a team setting
- Follows projects through review and feedback process
