COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

August 4, 2020, Swinomish Public Health has confirmed zero (0) new cases of COVID-19 in the last 24hrs. Although there are several tests collected still pending results.

The Public Health Team is continuing tracing for active COVID-19 cases in the community including notification of close contacts.

A close contact for COVID-19 is defined as anyone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes starting from 48 hours before the person began feeling sick, or tested positive until the time the person began to isolate.

What should I do if I had close contact with someone with COVID-19?

- Call the clinic
- Get tested
- Stay in and self-quarantine
