

COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

August 11, 2020 – Swinomish Public Health confirmed **zero (0)** new case of COVID-19 in the last 24 hours, although there are tests still pending results.

The Medical Clinic is hosting a COVID-19 testing drive-thru for the community TODAY from

9 am-1pm in the Social Services parking area.

When should I be tested? COVID-19 testing recommendations depend on many factors. Here are some general guidelines you can use to determine your need for testing:

- Every 7-14 days, depending on the risks you take on a daily basis.
- If you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, it is best to wait five days after the time of exposure. This is generally how long it takes before testing can detect the virus.
- Swinomish is not limiting testing for community members. If you would like to talk with a provider about your individual situation, please call us at (360) 466-3167.
