

## **COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE**

August 18, 2020 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **zero (0)** new cases of COVID-19 in the last 11 day.

The Healthcare Team is hosting a COVID-19 testing drive-thru for the community today from

9 am-1 pm in the Social Services parking area.

When should I be tested? COVID-19 testing recommendations depend on many factors. Here are some general guidelines you can use to determine your need for testing:

- Every 7-14 days, depending on the risks you take on a daily basis.
- If you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, it is best to wait five days after the time of exposure. This is generally how long it takes before testing can detect the virus.
