COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

December 19, 2020 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **one (1) new case** of COVID-19 in the community in the last 24 hours.

Today is the last Saturday before Christmas. The safest thing to do is stay home; avoid crowds, including grocery and gift shopping. If you must go out, please follow CDC advice on running essential errands during the pandemic. Although holiday shopping may not be essential, much of the same advice applies. Here are the most important recommendations to follow for your holiday shopping:

- Wear a mask that covers your mouth and nose.
- Maintain social distancing of at least six feet from others when possible.
- Carry hand sanitizer and use it after leaving the store.
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds after you get home.

The clinic will be open for limited services through the Tribe's holiday break.
