COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

March 11, 2021 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed nine (9) new cases of COVID-19 in the community in the last 24 hours. There are tests still pending results.

COVID-19 is still here and there is significant risk of getting it. We must all continue taking precautions in order to stop the spread:

- Wear a face mask when outside the home, as required by Senate resolution
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds several times a day
- Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet when interacting with those outside your household
- Only leave your home for essential purposes
- If you have been instructed to quarantine, only leave your home to seek medical care
- Only allow household members in your home, avoid entering other people’s homes

Vaccinated people can potentially still get COVID-19 and spread it to others. If you are vaccinated, your chances of getting a severe infection are decreased. However, you can still spread it. Perhaps less easily, but this is still an unconfirmed unknown.

The Youth Center and youth programs are closed out of caution while contact tracing is being conducted. This does not mean everyone involved in these programs is a contact. It is safest to stay home and keep your kids home if possible. If you have reason to believe you are a contact and have not yet been contacted by a contact tracer, please call the Medical Clinic at (360) 466-3167. Also call the clinic if you or your child would like to receive a test as a precaution.
