COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

April 8, 2021 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **three (3) new cases** of COVID-19 in the community. There are tests pending results.

COVID-19 is still here and there is significant risk of getting it. We must all continue taking precautions in order to stop the spread.

- Wear a face mask when outside the home, as required by Senate resolution
- Wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds several times a day
- Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet when interacting with those outside your household
- Only leave your home for essential purposes
- If you have been instructed to quarantine, only leave your home to seek medical care
- Only allow household members in your home, avoid entering other people’s homes

Vaccinated people can potentially still get COVID-19 and spread it to others. If you are vaccinated, your chances of getting a severe infection are decreased. However, you can still spread it. Perhaps less easily, but this still an unconfirmed unknown.
