COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

August 16, 2021 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **three (3) new cases** of COVID-19 in the community since the last health update August 13. There are tests still pending results.

If you have concerns about possible exposure, please come for drive-thru testing at the Medical Clinic tomorrow (Tuesdays) between 2-3:30 p.m. Testing is also available Monday-Friday by appointment. Regular testing is encouraged.

The CDC recommends people who have moderately to severely compromised immune systems receive an additional dose of mRNA COVID-19 vaccine at least 28 days after receiving the initial two doses.

This includes people who have:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last two years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress immune response

The Medical Clinic is now able to offer booster shots to immunocompromised individuals. CDC does not recommend boosters for any other population at this time. Walk-in vaccine appointments are welcome Monday-Thursday from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. or call (360) 466-3167 to make an appointment.
