## COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

**September 2, 2021** – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **eight (8) new cases** of COVID-19 in the community since the last update Tuesday, August 31. There are test results still pending.

Skagit County is seeing its highest increase in COVID-19 case numbers since the onset of the pandemic. Case counts are higher now than they were last winter! Vaccinated people are largely avoiding serious infection and death from COVID-19, but both vaccinated and unvaccinated people are getting sick and infecting others. The hospitals are full.

We must all take precautions:

- Wear a face mask, as required by Senate resolution.
- Avoid gathering, but if you do, maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet.
- If you enter a crowded area and you don't want COVID-19, leave.
- If you have been instructed to quarantine, only leave your home to seek medical care.
- Get vaccinated. Without it, you are at risk for a serious COVID-19 infection.

Walk-in vaccine appointments are welcome Monday-Thursday from 9 a.m.-4 p.m., or by appointment. Drive-thru testing is available every Tuesday from 2-3:30 p.m., or by appointment.
