## COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

**October 4, 2021** – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **two (2) new cases** of COVID-19 in the community since the last update Thursday, September 30. There are test results still pending.

Vaccinated or not, if you have symptoms of COVID-19, get tested ASAP and isolate away from other people. If you are exposed to COVID-19, quarantine and get tested in 3-5 days. If your test is negative, test again in 3-5 days.

Even a tickle in your throat can be significant and warrant testing! Symptoms to look out for: fever or chills; cough; shortness of breath; fatigue; muscle or body aches; headache; loss of taste or smell; sore throat; congestion or runny nose; nausea or vomiting; diarrhea

**Drive-thru COVID-19 testing is available every Tuesday from 2-4:30 p.m., or by appointment. Vaccines are by appointment. Please call the Swinomish Medical Clinic at (360) 466-3167 to schedule.**
