COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

November 12, 2021 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **twelve (12) new cases** of COVID-19 in the community since the last update Monday, November 8. There are test results still pending.

Skagit County has the highest COVID-19 case rate in the state. Vaccinated or not, it is critical we all mask up, keep our physical distance, and avoid gathering indoors and in poorly ventilated areas, especially as we enter the colder months and holiday season. Clear spikes in infection rates can be seen after holidays since the beginning of the pandemic.

Details about vaccines for kids will be available early next week.

Moderna boosters and the initial two dose vaccine series are available by appointment at the clinic. Drive-thru COVID-19 testing is available every Tuesday from 2-4 p.m., or by appointment.

Flu vaccines are available by appointment or walk-in Monday-Thursday.
