

JUROR QUALIFICATION / HARDSHIP FORM

I am not legally qualified to serve as a juror with the Swinomish Tribal Court because:

- I am a member of the Swinomish Tribe but I reside outside of Skagit County

- I am not a member of the Swinomish Tribe and I reside outside of the Swinomish Reservation.

- On the date of the summons I will be less than 18 years of age.

- I have been convicted of a felony and have not yet had my civil rights restored.

- At the time the jury list was prepared and/or currently I am a tribal judge, tribal police officer, General Manager, or an employee within the tribal Wellness Program, didgwálic̓, Office of the Tribal Attorney, or Swinomish Indian Senator.

If you are unable to serve due to a medical/physical/psychological condition, please provide a letter from your doctor supporting being excused from this obligation.

Jury trial can take 1—3 days. If you feel it would be an undue hardship, extreme inconvenience, public necessity or any reason deemed sufficient by the Court please explain below.

I HEREBY CERTIFY UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY UNDER SWINOMISH AND WASHINGTON LAW THAT I AM THE PERSON NAMED ON THE SUMMONS AND THAT THE INFORMATION I PROVIDE IS TRUE AND ACCURATE.
