COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH NOTICE

September 7, 2022 – Swinomish Public Health has confirmed **17 new cases** of COVID-19 in the community since the last update Tuesday, Aug. 23. **Total cases: 1,215**

Case rates in Skagit and Snohomish are still considered high. Please consider wearing a mask when gathering indoors — not only for yourself, but for those you live with. Use the COVID-19 Helpline if you have questions or need support including treatment or symptom control.

Another support option is the Washington State Department of Health which now has treatment options accessible online at doh.wa.gov/emergencies/covid-19/treatments/free-telehealth or by phone: 1 (800) 525-0127.

BIG NEWS: The Moderna and Pfizer booster vaccines with omicron coverage are now available to everyone age 12 years and up! For those eligible to be seen at the Swinomish Medical Clinic, the bivalent booster will be available for ages 18+, and the primary series for 6 months+, in the tent outside the clinic **starting TOMORROW, Sept. 8, from 8 a.m.-5 p.m. No appointment necessary.** Please bring your COVID-19 vaccine record if you have it.

If supply and time allow, vaccine will be made available to tribal employees and their families. Call the clinic if you would like to get on the call list for available vaccine.
