## **PART I**

### **Petition for an Order for Protection**

This document asks the court to protect you from domestic violence. It gives the judge information about why a protection order is needed. You do not have to be physically injured in order to qualify for an order. If you can tell the court about why you are afraid of harm, you may be able to get an order.

This form can be used to request both temporary protection AND extended protection. If the court finds that an emergency exists, the court may issue a temporary order immediately. At the same time the court will set a hearing to determine if the order for protection should be issued. Because of this procedure, it is necessary for you to fill out both parts of the form at the same time.

### **Preliminary Information**

Fill in your name as the Petitioner. The person you are asking to be protected from is the "Respondent". Fill in the Respondent's date of birth.

#### **Who Needs Protection** (Question 1)

The court must know who needs protection. Check the first box if you need protection. Check the second box if someone in your family or household needs protection. You may check both boxes.

#### **Residency** (Question 2)

The court needs to know where you live to determine if the court can issue a protection order. Check ONE of the boxes to tell the court about where you currently live.

#### **Age** (Question 3)

The court needs to know the ages of both parties. Check ONE of the boxes for your age. Check ONE of the boxes for the Respondent's age.

#### **Relationship** (Question 4)

The court must know the relationship between you and the Respondent. Check the boxes that describe your situation.

### **Identification of Petitioner** (Question 5)

The court needs the petitioner's name, date of birth and address, to help the court and tribal police. If you have concerns about your safety by disclosing your address information, tell the court clerk.

### **Identification of Respondent** (Question 6)

The court needs the respondent's name, date of birth and address so that the court and tribal police can serve notice of this, and future court orders.

### **Minors** (Question 7)

The court needs to know about the children in this case. List each child's name, date of birth, age, and, sex. Fill in how that child is related to you (for example, son). Fill in how that child is related to the Respondent. Fill in with whom that child lives (for example: me, grandparent, Respondent). The same information is required for any other family members that also need protection.

### **Court Cases** (Question 8)

This may not be the first court proceeding between you and the Respondent. The court will need to know about the other cases so the court does not issue an order that might conflict with an order from another court.

If there are other cases between you and the Respondent, list the case title (the parties' names), the case number (if you know it), and the court (tribal, district, municipal, or superior) and the county.

## **PART II**

### **Request for Temporary Order**

These are the different kinds of temporary protection you may need today before a hearing. Check off everything in the furthest left-hand column that you think you may need before a hearing.

1. The first item asks the court to keep the Respondent from physically harming or harassing the people you indicate.
  - a. Check the box "me" if you need protection.
  - b. Check "the minors named in paragraph 7 above" if all of the children you listed need protection.
  - c. Check "these minors only" if some of the children require protection. If you check this box, make sure to list the names of the children needing protection.
2. The second item asks the court to order the Respondent not to contact you or the children or family members that you name.
3. The third item asks the court to order the Respondent to stay away from your home. If you need to keep your address a secret, check the "confidential" box. Otherwise, fill in your

present address. Enforcement of the Order may be easier if your address is included.

4. The fourth item asks the court to order the Respondent to leave the home the two of you share.
5. The fifth item asks the court to order the Respondent to stay away from your school or where you work. If there is someplace else you want to include, add it to the box called "Other".
6. The sixth item asks the court to give you the temporary care, custody and control of the children you name.
7. The seventh item asks the court to order the Respondent not to interfere with your custody of the children you name.
8. The eighth item asks the court to order the Respondent not to remove the listed children from the state.
9. The ninth item asks the court to grant you possession of essential personal effects.
10. The tenth item asks the court to grant you use of a vehicle (i.e., 1994 blue Ford Taurus, License No. XYZ123).
11. The eleventh item asks the court to order the Respondent to get treatment or counseling.
12. The twelfth item asks the court to make the order last longer than one year. Check this only if there is reason to believe the Respondent would resume the acts of domestic violence against you if the order expired in one year.

**DO NOT TRY TO FILL IN THE GREY BOXES THAT ARE ON THE FORM.  
THEY DO NOT APPLY TO TEMPORARY ORDERS.**

Tell the court why you need a protection order. If there is an emergency, explain the emergency so the court can issue a temporary order before the hearing. Talk about the violence or threats that have happened most recently to you, your children, or family members. The more details you can provide, the more helpful it is to the judge. List several examples if you can. If the Respondent has hurt other people or been arrested, tell about that. Tell the judge **exactly** what happened when you or your family members were threatened or hurt.

EXAMPLE:

It is better to say "On Sunday Terry slapped my face"  
rather than "On Sunday Terry assaulted me."

It is better to say "Terry threatened to hit me if I left the  
house" rather than "Terry threatened me".

Try to use the exact words that were said.

Start with the most recent act. You also may want to list incidents where the police came to your home because of domestic violence, even if no arrests were made.

When you are done with your statement, put today's date in the date line and fill in the city/location where you are completing this form. Sign the form.

Violation of the provisions of this order with actual notice of its terms will subject a violator to arrest. You are notified that this Court will seek jail time as a remedy for violation of this Court's Order. Respondent will be liable for the costs of jail time.

Violation of this order is a **Class C offense** unless one of the following conditions apply: Any assault that is a violation of this order and that does not amount to a Class A assault pursuant to STC 4-02.020(B) is a **Class B offense**. Any conduct in violation of this order that is reckless and creates a substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to another person is a **Class B offense**. Also, a violation of this order is a **Class B offense** if the respondent has at least 2 previous convictions for violating a protection order issued under Swinomish law or any Federal or state law that is comparable to Swinomish law.

Any conduct in violation of this order that is reckless and creates a substantial risk of death or serious physical injury to another person is a **Class B offense**. Also, a violation of this order is a **Class B offense** if the respondent has at least 2 previous convictions for violating a protection order issued under Swinomish law or any Federal or state law that is comparable to Swinomish law.

**YOU CAN BE ARRESTED EVEN IF THE PERSON OR PERSONS WHO OBTAINED THE ORDER INVITE OR ALLOW YOU TO VIOLATE THE ORDER'S PROHIBITIONS.** You have the sole responsibility to avoid or refrain from violating the order's provisions. Only the court can change the order upon written application.
